Please complete the attached travel vaccination form, giving full details of your proposed trip abroad and dates of travel. This will enable us to plan the necessary vaccination programme you will require for your travel.

Please give as much notice as possible of your travel plans, as it may take some time to complete a full course of vaccinations. However, it is never too late to seek advice.

It is very important that you seek medical advice about health risks in your destination country. If you have a medical condition, you are advised to discuss the suitability of the trip before you book and also inform your travel insurance company about your medical condition (s).

IT IS IDEAL TO ALLOW AT LEAST 10 WEEKS FOR VACCINATIONS TO BE GIVEN BEFORE YOU TRAVEL.

Please bring the fully completed form (one for each person travelling) to your Travel Clinic appointment.

Some vaccinations and prescriptions for anti-malarial tablets that you are unable to purchase will incur a charge as they are not available on the NHS. Please see the list for charges. For some of these vaccinations or prescriptions, a second appointment at the Travel Clinic may be necessary.

Please note: You will be asked to pay our fees prior to administration of vaccinations or the collection of prescriptions for anti-malarial tablets. You will not be able to receive your vaccination until you have paid the necessary fee, for which you will be issued with a receipt as proof of payment.

Please note: Your Health Partnership are not Yellow Fever Centres. If you require Yellow Fever vaccination, please enquire when you attend the Travel Clinic.
